

Trailheads with parking and limited restroom facilities, map kiosks, and signs make Terre Haute easily accessible.

In the southeast portion of Terre Haute, approximately 18 acres of flat to moderately steep ground accommodates a recreation facility. This facility could include an indoor pool, ice hockey arena, or health and recreation center.

An environmental education nature trail and picnic area connect adjacent neighborhoods to Terre Haute on a Town-owned parcel of 23 acres in the north portion of the industrial park.


CONCEPT 1: GATEWAY TO RECREATION
