- Reminder: All cot straps should be used when loading and transporting a patient. On any uneven surfaces, have extra hands to stabilize the cot.
- The hospital released its list of upcoming CME's. Copies are in the radio room and EMS office.
- We have conducted two complete sessions of annual required BBP and EMS training sessions. We will look into having additional sessions if needed.
