Some of those waiting, might sign up for another session.

The following programs are being planned: Road Race (over 100 entrants to date--more coming); Summer Open Gym; Basketball Shooting Camp (17 girls); Track and Field Series; Tennis Camps and Lessons; US Sports Institute Programs; Chess Camp; Boys Lacrosse Camps; Football Camps; Performing Arts Camp; Baseball Camp; and BYSA Soccer Camp. All those programs that have already started are going well.

Morton Building turned our new maintenance building over to us with locks on the doors and looking good. The floor still must be pored and the tank removed. More on this next month.

July will be busy with tournaments in town in baseball and softball. and BMX. Merchants have been notified and organizations are making plans.


