A site walk was conducted to review and study the diverse environment of the Ice Pond. W. Michael guided the commission and showed them the different species that were living in the pond. The commission found a rare find for the time of day, which was a spotted salamander. The salamander is secretive and usually has its home underground and will only come out at night in the rain. Some of the other finds that W. Michael had shown the commission was the salamander membrane sacs holding the eggs and the newborn salamanders.
