D. Goodrich called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m.

MINUTES

Motion made by D. Goodrich and seconded by K. Stevens to approve the minutes as presented. Motion passed with P. Perrefort abstaining.

INLAND WETLANDS AGENTS REPORT

B. Cavagna handed out a letter of response from the owner of 4 Walnut Hill Road. The owner stated that he would have no problem with tearing down bridge.

Motion made by D. Goodrich and seconded by K. Stevens to have B. Cavagna respond back to the owner of 4 Walnut Hill Road asking him to remove the bridge by April 1st, 2010. Motion passed unanimously.

B. Cavagna handed out a memo to the commission that was addressed to Dan Rossi, P.E. Land Development, Toll Brothers from B. Cavagna, dated 2/2/10 regarding the Summit – Wooster Street – Storm Event 1/25/10, memo from Larry Oisher to B. Cavagna, and memo from Tom Daly to B. Cavagna dated 2/5/10. She wanted to give this to the commission for information

purposes. The commission was comfortable with these memos regarding the erosion control/drainage issues for the Summit-Wooster Street.

Motion made by D. Goodrich and seconded by P. Perrefort to add “Old World Builders” onto the agenda. Motion passed unanimously.

OLD WORLD BUILDERS



She showed the commission videos of where the wetlands crossings were and how the loggers were there without putting down tracking pads. The consensus of the commission was to have the owner of the logging company come before the commission.

B. Cavagna is asking the commission for permission to take action on a Cease & Desist order based on the evidence she had shown to the commission.

Motion made by K. Stevens and seconded by P. Perrefort to have the Inland Wetlands Officer issue a Cease & Desist Order to Genesis Properties, LLC. Motion passed unanimously.

Motion made by D. Goodrich and seconded by K. Stevens to adjourn at 7:31p.m. Motion passed unanimously.
