Appeal of Personal Property P40419, GFT, LLC; Adjustment: \$0; Reason: Assessment was deemed to be fair and reasonable. Decision was unanimous. The 25% penalty for late filing remains as per state statute.

Appeal of Personal Property P42461, Wanderlust Tea Company; Adjustment: \$0; Reason: Assessment was deemed to be fair and reasonable. Decision was unanimous. The 25% penalty for not filing remains as per state statute.

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
