PREVENT HOME HEATING FIRE

- Keep all potential sources of fuel like paper, clothing, bedding or rugs at least three feet away from space heaters, stoves, or fireplaces.
- Portable heaters and fireplaces should never be left unattended. Turn off space heaters and make sure any embers in the fireplace are extinguished before going to bed or leaving homes.
- If you must use a space heater, place it on a level, hard and nonflammable surface (such as ceramic tile floor), not on rugs or carpets or near bedding or drapes. Keep children and pets away from space heaters.
- When buying a space heater, look for models that shut off automatically if the heater falls over as another safety measure.

If a fire occurs in your home, **GET OUT, STAY OUT** and **CALL** for help.

Install smoke alarms on every level of your home, inside bedrooms and outside sleeping areas. Test them every month and replace the batteries at least once a year.

Talk with all household members about a **fire escape plan** and practice the plan twice a year.

NOTICE IS HERBY GIVEN, pursuant to Section 16-50g et seq. of the Connecticut General Statutes, as amended, and Section 16-50j-1 et seq. of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies, as amended, of the intent of MCM Holdings, LLC ("MCM") (the "Applicant") to file an Application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Need with the Connecticut Siting Council ("Siting Council") on or after August 14, 2023 to construct a wireless telecommunications tower facility ("Facility") at 3 Marchant Road in the Town of Redding.

The Facility is proposed on an approximately 174-acre acre parcel of land owned by the Connecticut Yankees Council Inc. (Boy Scouts of America) located at 3 Marchant Road in the Town of Redding (the "Parcel" or "Camp Hoyt") and is identified as Parcel ID 12-29 on the Town of Redding Tax Map.

The Facility consists of a monopole structure that is 150' tall located within a fenced equipment compound in the center of the approximately 174-acre host parcel with access from Sempaung Turnpike. Verizon's antennas would be installed at a centerline height of approximately 146' above grade level and the Facility will be designed to support the antennas and equipment of other FCC licensed wireless carriers as well as local emergency communications equipment.

The Application explains the need, purpose and benefits of the Facility and also describes the environmental impacts of the proposed Facility.

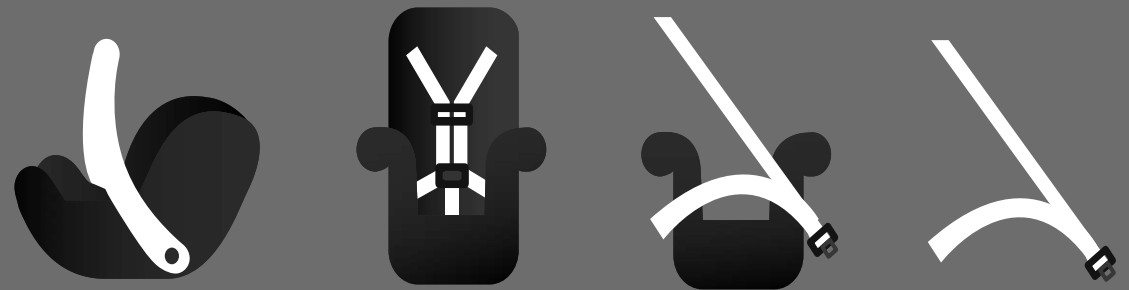
