Responsible for code enforcement and inspection work involving the review of site and construction plans for new residential buildings and for the examination of residential buildings in the process of construction, renovation or repair to assure conformance with applicable local codes, ordinances and regulations, national electrical codes and plumbing and heating codes on all residential building construction, alterations, and demolition. High school education or vocational school or completion of an apprenticeship training program in a construction skill and no less than four (4) years' experience and training which provides the knowledge, skills and abilities required. Certification by the State of Connecticut as an Assistant Building Official, plus mandatory continuing education through seminars. Must possess a valid CT motor vehicle operator's license. Application can be obtained on the Town's website or in the Human Resources Department. The application process will remain open until position is filled.
