All involved were invited This was an open discussion and a lot of good information to use in the future. The Emergency Reporting software continues to evolve. Things that are up and running

- Fire incidents (INFRS) reports are all done here. Fire attendance logs no longer used. Program will generate report
- Training logs are now all documented in the system Please remember to sign in to get credit.
- Events are now log in the system to track attendance.
- EMS calls are entered into this system as an event from the attendance logs to allow both fire and EMS call in one system
- Weekly Apparatus checks now done on this system. This will help the chief engineer track who is doing and who is not.
- Equipment is logged in the system and who or what apparatus it is assigned to. We now know who has what and the history of the item i.e. repairs, cleaning and replacement date
- Certifications have been entered and is flagging member who expire soon
- The town has been making repairs around the fire house such as sheet rock damage weather stripping and will be addressing counter tops. Please let Captain Gunter know if see any needed repairs.

ERM has had some staffing changes. They have hired 3 new EMT's to cover our staffing needs. Some are starting as early as this week. Feel free to stop by and introduce yourself.
