There were 71 calls for the month of April, 2021, giving us 301 calls for the year, compared to 322 in 2020 (a 6% decrease). In April:

- 14 volunteers provided at least 8 hours of EMS on-call coverage.
- 20 volunteers made at least 1 call.
- The top responding officers were:
  - Chief Engineer Patrick Magyar with 13 calls
  - Chief John Baker with 11 calls
  - EMS Captain Jim Mangi with 6 calls
- The top responding members were:
  - Chuck Cywin with 10 calls
  - Chelsea Berg and James L'Hernault with 8 calls each
- ERM made 37 calls as a complete crew.
- ERM completed the crew with an EMT on 9 calls.
  
- Of the 71 calls,
  - 31 were BLS (do not include calls where care was transferred as they could be ALS)
  - 24 were ALS
  - 2 were RMA's (include this number with BLS calls)
  - 5 were treated and refused transport (include this number with BLS calls)
  - 1 was treated and care transferred (Stony Hill 2<sup>nd</sup> call, assist, or A3 OOS)
  - 4 canceled enroute
  - 2 canceled prior to response
  - 2 no patient found
  - 1 dead on scene
  - 17 were for Bethel Health Care
  - 4 were for Maplewood of Bethel
  - 11 were night calls (between 22:00 and 06:00)
  - 1 first call covered by mutual aid.
  - 5 were second (or additional) calls covered by mutual aid.

- With many of us fully vaccinated, please keep in mind we should still be doing self checks regularly, including looking for any symptoms, and taking your temperature daily. If you need an infrared thermometer, we may still have a few left. There should also be one in the radio room.
- Nuvance has updated their Emergency Department visitation policies. For Danbury Hospital the following is effective May 4, 2021 (the two items below are from a May 3<sup>rd</sup> e-mail from Nuvance):
  - Limited visitation in the Emergency Department is permitted for patients without suspected or confirmed COVID disease, and they will be allowed one (non-changing) screened support person. Given social distancing and safe-occupancy limitation requirements, the support person will not be allowed to use the wait-room and will be instructed to wait safely outside the hospital and rejoin the patient once the patient is escorted into a private treatment room (special populations and extenuating circumstances excluded). Please note ED Visitation may be paused for safety or operational concerns.
  - Patients with suspected or confirmed COVID disease will not be permitted a support person unless the patient is under age 21, a maternity patient or if extenuating circumstances apply.
- I (Jim Mangi) thank the department, and especially Rita and Kenny Parciasepe, for the flowers sent to my mother's wake.
- EMS Lt. Kenny Carney requested that EMS members see him after the meeting to go over open shifts on the EMS Coverage Schedule.
