Food Scrap Waste – Food Scraps have their own container \$1.00 per bucket. FOOD SCRAPS ACCEPTED – Fruits, Nuts & Vegetables (remove bands, ties, and stickers); Household Plants and Floral Bouquets; Plate Scrapings; Sauces, Soup & Gravy; Coffee Grounds, Filters & Tea Bags; Dairy Products & Egg Shells; Bread, Pasta & Grains; Meat & Poultry (bones also); Fish (including Shellfish)

Tables, Chairs, End Table, Bed Frames, Desks, Dressers, Carpet, etc.
\$0.25 per lb.

Couches (fee dependent on size of couch) \$25 - \$35 per item
