MINUTES OF SPECIAL MEETING

Call to Order/ Pledge of Allegiance: Nick Ellis called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

Consideration of PUC project approval of: the Water System Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) Upgrade Project, for an amount not to exceed \$1,161,555.00. Said sum includes the construction costs of \$728,990.00; professional services of \$376,115.00; bonding and legal fees of \$20,000.00; and, a total project contingency of 5% in the amount of \$36,450.00. Possibility of a loan and grant from the State of CT.:

Public Utilities Director, Tom Villa, gave an overview of the project. Discussion ensued. Motion made by John Lennon, and seconded by Will Duff, to approve a recommendation by the Public Utilities Commission to fund an amount, not to exceed \$1,161,555.00 for the Water System Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition ("SCADA") Upgrade Project. Said sum includes the construction costs of \$728,990.00; professional services of \$376,115.00; bonding and legal fees of \$20,000.00; and, a total project contingency of 5% in the amount of \$36,450.00. Said funding shall come from bonding, bond anticipatory notes, loans, temporary borrowing and/or other appropriation as recommended by the Comptroller to be reduced by any available grants obtained by the Town of Bethel and/or the Bethel Public Utilities Commission, if any. Payment for the appropriated sums shall be made by the water account users of the Bethel Public Utilities Commission. Vote, all in favor. Motion carries.
