SOCIAL SERVICES REPORT: Megan Alworth-Khazadian presented her report. Diane Golden made a motion to accept the report, seconded by Pat Smithwick. Motion passed unanimously. 244 families are now registered with the food pantry. 174 summer baskets will be delivered by BIA.

OLD BUSINESS: Discussion continued on the subject of tax relief. It will be addressed again in the Fall.

NEW BUSINESS: Housing needs continue to be a serious concern. It was suggested that the problem be looked at more fully at the next meeting.
