Dear David:

I realize that I have not responded to your most recent staff report concerning the Notification of the landscaping and riverbank restoration project at 7 Rockwell Road. You have pointed out in Paragraph #4 of the report that the Notification only includes work at 7 Rockwell Road. The work on the eastern most bank of Limekiln Brook will require the owner of that property to file a Notification which I will try to obtain. In the interim, I would like to resolve any questions with respect to the work at the subject property.

I am enclosing herewith pictures of the condition of the area that was repaired prior to the commencement of the work which is the subject of the notification.

With respect to the location of the materials that are native to the site, there is really no exact record of where these miscellaneous stones were taken but a lot of them came from the area along Rockwell Road. Some of the native stone was just a rebuilding of the bank itself with stones that were eroding into the brook.

With respect to the verified petition to intervene, as mentioned in Paragraph #8 of your report, that does not seem to be of any merit at this point since the application for which the intervention was sought has been withdrawn. At this point, the matter before the Commission is limited to the issues that have been raised in the notification.
